He is probably fitting in and maybe making new friends. He is proud of himself for doing a good thing to make a bad thing feel right: so he does not feel bad about anything. This is symbolized in the designs because people wrote about it and drew an example.

I learned that drunk driving is very dangerous and that if something bad happens and you did it try and fix it. Don't be miserably guilty the rest of your life. Make new friends. Don't give up. Be a good person to others and yourself. Keep trying because if you don't you will not get far in your life, at all.
